## **RRHA Announces Stimulus Funds Job Opportunity Workshops for Residents**

**Richmond, VA** – The Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority (RRHA) announces U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), Section 3 employment opportunities. Section 3 is a provision of the HUD Act of 1968 that promotes local economic development, neighborhood economic improvement and individual self-sufficiency. Through RRHA, public housing residents and income-qualified citizens who live in the area and have a household income which falls below HUD's income limits are provided a chance to secure employment through Section 3. As a result of recent Stimulus Funds awarded to RRHA, there are increased employment opportunities through the contracts which will be awarded.

"We are excited to offer these job opportunities," says Anthony Scott, RRHA executive director. "They are a win-win for our residents and the City of Richmond. Our residents get on the road to self-sufficiency and the City's economy gets a boost."

- Drug screening and background check required
- Positions may include clerical, general labor and construction
