Executive Director Sheila Hill-Christian continues to make presentation to various stakeholders, businesses and organizations regarding partnership and the roles they can play in making the plan a success.

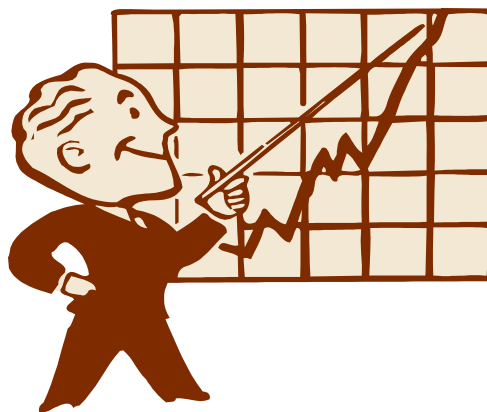
There are even positive changes in various departments resulting from RRHA's new values and goals.

Changes include:

- RRHA University is offering new classes for residents and staff, in addition to other services; began an online newsletter
- HCVP, Housing Management, and Finance have become heavily involved in the Enterprise Application Software (EAS) Project. Together they will significantly change

the way we perform our business on a daily basis

- The budget process has been revamped to align approved budgets with the strategic plan and will become a blueprint for what business is performed in the upcoming year
- The Finance and Administration Department has been reorganized



- Increased focus on public safety initiatives
